Attendees: This course is designed for Undercover and Plainclothes Officers/Detectives/Agents/Supervisors assigned to Narcotics, Gangs, Intelligence, Internal Affairs, Vice, Human Trafficking, or Specialized Units.

Course Description: This Two-week (80 hour) "Classroom and Practical Scenario" training has been designed to bring an inexperienced undercover to an advanced level, and expand the knowledge of the experienced undercover even further. Dave's practical "pay it forward" type of training has come from 20 years of undercover instruction and 25 years of undercover experience. Having trained over 13,000 undercover personnel Internationally and Nationally, Instructor Dave Redemann learned early in his teaching career that even though he was blessed to have a wide array of undercover experience and knowledge, he couldn't obtain the knowledge of more than 13,000 undercover personnel on his own. Through the 20 years of undercover practical scenario training, Dave has realized that one of the most beneficial types of training is "realism" based training. "Practical Scenario" video recorded training allows a student to learn in the most realistic environment without the deadly consequences of mistakes. Some of the scenarios include: street level narcotics buys, in vehicle narcotics buys, middle and upper level narcotics buys, street level prostitution, escort prostitution, outlaw motorcycle gangs, white supremacist, murder and arson for hire to name a few. The videotaping of scenarios allows the student to visually and audibly reviews their performance along side of an experienced undercover. The scenarios are designed to progress on a crawl, walk, run degree of difficulty. Dave's goal is to provide training to officers/detectives in an effort to try and make sure every officer gets home to their loved ones each and every night. His training is updated with the most current and relevant information each and every time it is instructed.

The training covers: UC Operations Overview – What, When, Where, Why, and How of Undercover Work; Surviving Traumatic Incidents - Identifying safety considerations and unique problems associated with undercover assignments; Psychological Pitfalls of Undercover Work - Identifying psychological challenges of undercover work and contact appropriate resources for counseling; Code 4 Northwest (Stress Management and confidential addiction treatment); Special Undercover Concerns - Identifying difficult undercover scenarios and demonstrate methods to get out of them safely and legally; Understand unique issues associated with women in undercover work; Demonstrate techniques for infiltration of certain criminal organizations; Case Management of UC Operations- Practice undercover operation planning and risk management principles; Confidential Informants - Effective recruitment and utilization of informants in undercover assignments; Buy/Bust Operations – Planning an operation and identifying all the roles involved; Demonstrate briefing and debriefing techniques for undercover operations; Undercover Supervision - Understand and practice key issues in the supervision of undercover personnel; Prosecutorial Aspects of Undercover Cases - Understand prosecutorial guidelines, regulations, and entrapment issues for federal and state court; Narcotics Demonstration - Hands-on exposure to narcotics and how they are manufactured, distributed, packaged, concealed and regional narcotics and organized crime trends - Live demonstration of the process of cooking crack-cocaine; Technical Support - Introduction and demonstration of specialized electronic equipment in undercover operations and criminal investigations; Surveillance Techniques – Use of static and mobile surveillance techniques "to see but not be seen"; DISCernment Personality Test - Self-evaluation and identification of strengths and weaknesses through DISC personality testing;

The training also provides "Laser Shot" a live scenario "shoot don't shoot" simulator. This training simulator has over 600 scenarios ranging from practical shooting techniques to "real life undercover and off duty" situations. This element of undercover training is one of a kind.

Instructor: Dave's twenty-five years undercover experience includes, but is not limited to, the following: vice, narcotics, organized crime, white supremacy groups, militia groups, Mexican drug trafficking organizations, outlaw motorcycle gangs, and assisting Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) undercover personnel on an international terror case. A large portion of Dave's cases involved long term infiltrations of criminal organizations lasting up to four years. Dave was tasked with infiltrating an Outlaw Motorcycle Gang. This assignment lasted for almost 4 years. Dave has spent roughly ten years of his undercover career living with the criminals he was investigating. While working undercover, Dave has purchased most levels of numerous types of narcotics, stolen vehicles, stolen property, guns, fully automatic guns, explosives, and hand grenades. Dave created and teaches at the Washington State Undercover School (since 1997) teaches at the F.B.I. undercover school (since 1997), Pennsylvania State Police "Top Gun" undercover school (since 2013), Midwest Counter Drug Training Center (since 2010), Regional Counterdrug Training Academy and additional military, federal, state and local agencies and organizations.

Sgt. Brandon James has been with the Seattle Police Department for over 15 years. He has supervised the Intelligence Unit and "deep" long term undercover operations for SPD and the FBI. He is an experienced FBI, narcotics, and intelligence undercover. He has investigated numerous criminal cases on corrupt police officers. He currently is the supervisor of a narcotics pro-active unit.
